Please read this installation manual carefully before use.

# **Safety Precautions**

Be sure to observe these precautions so as to use the product correctly and prevent injuries or damage to property.



#### Warning



**Do not connect multiple power plugs to one outlet.** It may result in a fire.



Do not use or keep the product and accessories for a long time at 0°C or lower or at 40°C or higher. It may cause fire, heat, or other dangers.



Do not bend the power cord too much and do not place heavy objects on the power adapter as it may become damaged.



Never disassemble, repair, or modify the product, accessories, or power adapter. This presents the danger of fire and electric shock.



Disconnect the the power adapter during thunder and lightning to avoid damage and fire.



**Do not let children or pets suck on or bite the product and accessories.** It may result in a fire or other dangers.



Do not drop or hit your remote control. This may cause a malfunction or injury.



Avoid placing the product and accessories in places where there is high temperature or moisture.

### $\odot$ Turning the unit on

Press the **Power** button on the RCU to turn the device on and off. Please refer to **Connections** before initial use.

### $\odot$ Turning the unit off

You can press the Power button to select **Sleep**, **Shutdown** or **Reboot**. To **Sleep**, **Shutdown**, press ► button to select off timer.



### **⊙ RF RCU** pairing

During the initial booting, a pairing screen will be displayed.



1. Press the •• and buttons at the same time for 2 seconds. 2. An "**OK**" message will be displayed after pairing is complete.

### $\odot$ First-time installation

Before you can watch television or listen to the radio, you must first perform the installation procedures.

The **First time installation** gives you the convenience of selecting various languages, displays setting, network setting, weather setting, channel location setting and channel search.

 Using the ▲/▼/ ⊕ (OK) buttons, select Country and Language settings. You can skip by pressing the ▼▷ (BLUE) button.



Press the (i) (OK) button to select Display Settings.
 Press (i) (OK) button to changes icon for move.
 Use the ▲/▼/◀/▶ buttons to change the display size.
 Press the (i) (Back) button to save.



- 6. Press the 🕑 (OK) button to select Network Settings.
- 7. Select Ethernet DHCP, Ethernet Manual or Wireless.
  - Ethernet DHCP : Automatic setting.
  - Ethernet Manual : Manual setting. (IP address, Sub-Netmask, Default gateway, DNS address)
  - Wi-Fi DHCP : Displays the Wi-Fi list.
  - Wi-Fi Manual : Manual setting.



 8. Press the ④ (OK) button to select Weather Settings. Use the ▲/▼/ ④ (OK) buttons to select the city name.



9. Press the (1) (OK) button to select Channel Location Settings.
 10. Using the ▲/▼/ (1) (OK) butons, select the channel search location.



- 11. Select ALL, FTA or Scramble and then press the (•) (**OK**) button to display the Channel Search screen.
- 12. Press the (1) (OK) button to save and then press (2) (Back) button.



13. Select ALL, FTA or Scramble and then press the (•) (OK) button.

#### \* Note

If you want to change the Antenna type, press the **ADD** (YELLOW) button.

Motor or USALS does not support multiple selection.

- 3. Select the **ALL**, **FTA** or **Scramble** menu items to display the Channel Search screen.
- 4. Press the 🗩 (**OK**) button to save.

NIT search is only supporteed in TP search mode.

### $\odot$ TP setting - edit

- 1. Use the  $\blacktriangle/\checkmark/\textcircled{(0)}$  (OK) buttons to select a satellite for TP edit. The blue indicator light should turn on.
- 2. Press the *P* (GREEN) button to display the Transponder Edit popup menu.
- 4. Set up the menu.

### $\odot$ Deleting a channel

- Use the ▲/▼/ (() (OK) buttons to select a satellite or transponder list. The blue indicator light should turn on.
- 2. To delete a channel, press the **BLUE** button.
- 3. Press the O (Back) button to return to the previous screen.

### $\odot$ Configuring the Home Screen

To display **Home Screen**, press and hold 🖀 (**Home**) button.



### $\odot$ Viewing program information



- 1. While watching a program, press the  $\oplus$  button to display the program information.
- 2. While the program information is displayed, press the  $\oplus$  button to display detailed program information

#### \* Note

Program information will disappear after five seconds of inactivity.

The Favorite group can be set in the Channel editor.
